### Soup Cook-Off Regulations

When? Saturday, October 1st

Where? Village Mall Clock Tower

### Cooking Rules

1. All entries must be homemade. No box mix allowed.
2. All cooking supplies and ingredients are to be supplied by each cooking team.
3. Basic health codes for event cooking shall be followed during preparation and distribution. It will be the responsibility of each team captain to maintain as healthy food-safe environment as possible throughout the event.
4. Each team is to make a minimum of 8 qts. (2gal) of their entrée.
5. You must be set up and ready to serve by 10:30am. Serving time is from 11am to 12:30pm for public sampling or until gone.

### Team Guidelines

1. Teams must pre-register in order to enter the contest, the entry form must be received no later than September 23rd, 2016. Space is limited, so register early.
2. Each team is to have a team name and team captain.
3. Contestants are responsible for supplying all of their own cooking utensils, etc.
4. Each team is to supply their own drinking water for cleaning and cooking.
5. Electrical power can be supplied to a limited number of teams, first come basis.
6. Team is to decorate their booth with an theme of their choice. (Optional)
7. Teams will be permitted to set up their equipment, decorations and cooking areas anytime after 10:00am on Friday, September 30th. Loading and unloading will only be allowed in designated areas.
8. Soup Cook-Off will NOT furnish any tables, chairs, electric cords, etc. All supplies are the responsibility of the contestants. (Exception: Spoons & Tasting Bowls will be provided by the Chamber of Commerce.)
9. (Sampling spoons & bowls will be handed out to ones purchasing armbands at the Chamber Event Booth.)
10. Each team will have a 10x10 cooking area.
11. It will be the responsibility of each team to clean up their cooking site at the end of the evening. Trash receptacles will be provided by Chamber of Commerce.

### Soup Cook-Off Judging

1. Judging will be based on taste, appearance, texture, and service.
2. Each soup will be judged by 2 anonymous persons. Winning team will be announced around 1:00pm.
3. The winning team will receive the honor their name engraved on the Soup Cook-Off plaque located in the Chamber office for all to see. Announcement will be under the Pavilion, & Bragging Rights to the winner!
